His Highness Shelish Modific bin Zayed Al Nabyan

A worthy successor to the best predecessor

«His Highness Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan is the second President of the United Arab Emirates announced on the second of December 1971, he is also the sixteenth ruler of the Emirate of Abu Dhabi, the biggest of the seven emirates constituent of the Federation».

To be the son of a gentleman and a great leader, this is certainly likable and be an extension of his qualities in the wisdom of the mind, the foresight and generous qualities, i.e.,

«A worthy successor to the best predecessor»

This is the challenge which cannot be afforded except by elite group of men who are given by the generosity of Allah a firm faith, supreme behavior, glowing and sound mind, and courage to determine justice, then prepare themselves to the enormity of

the tasks imitating the biography and qualities of ancestors, and their deeds, to be an anchor and guide to uphold what they have accomplished.

His Highness Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan,



may God protect him, is a model for the elite men, he had seen light «was born» in 1948 in a good family and a great house at Al Ain city, for a man who held all the noble qualities which enabled him to be a maker of history not only for Al Ain nor the Emirate of Abu Dhabi alone, but for the region through the



establishment of the UAE and its renaissance building until it became a beacon among the Arab countries and in the world.

His full name is «Khalifa bin Zayed bin Sultan bin Zayed bin Khalifa bin bin Shakhboot Bin Diab Bin Isa Bin Nahyan Bin Falah Bin Yas», and Nahyan Bin Falah is the first ruler of the Emirate of Abu Dhabi, «the second half of the eighteenth century».

His Highness was born in 1948 in the eastern region of the Emirate of Abu Dhabi and received his primary education in the city of Al Ain, the regional capital and its administrative center, he is the eldest son of the late Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, while his mother is HH Sheikha Hessa bint Mohammed bin Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan, His Highness returns to Bani Yas tribe, which is the mother of most of the Arab tribes that settled in what is today known as the United Arab Emirates and led an alliance of Arab tribes known historically as the «Bani Yas Alliance».

And His Highness Sheikh Khalifa is married to Her Highness Sheikha Shamsa bint Suhail Al Mazroui and has eight children, two boys are: HH Sheikh Sultan Bin Khalifa Al Nahyan and His Highness Sheikh Mohammed Bin Khalifa Al Nahyan, six girls, and has a number of grandchildren at different ages.

Of his speech upon his appointment as crown prince of Abu Dhabi «I was not in advance aware of the decision, but I was aware of the gravity of the responsibility and duties»

An early appointment with the responsibility

His Highness Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan was very close to his father, Sheikh Zayed may Allah have mercy on him when he was a representative of the Ruler of the Emirate of Abu Dhabi in Al Ain and the Eastern Region, and that period of his life was tremendous, he gor familiar with the art of leadership and management, and after three years from Sheikh Zayed may Allah have mercy on him receipt of governance in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi in 1969, Sheikh Khalifa was appointed as a crown prince, and he was then 21 years old.

This appointment was welcomed broadly by the ruling family of Al Nahyan and the local social communities, for what the family and community has seen from Sheikh Khalifa of good qualities and traits.

Here it is worth to note the presence of Sheikh Zayed as his idol which has helped him to perform the tasks entrusted to him, he highlighted what he learnt from his father in that period as quoted «patience, forbearance and deliberation in all things and reflection so as not to be surprised by anything» and that as the eldest son of Sheikh Zayed and his right hand in building the structure of the state he was very close to the exact details and the daily life of citizens, which make his life full of multi-various activities.

His Highness, recalling the memories of his appointment as crown prince, says: «I shall not broadcast a secret if I say I did not know in advance the decision taken by my father His Highness, even though I was at that day in the prime of life, but I was fully conscious of the gravity of this responsibility and what it means of great duties and responsibility».

In 1969 he held his Crown Prince of Abu Dhabi and began steps to create a federal entity for the United Arab Emirates that take accelerated dimensions and Sheikh Zayed was the focus of these steps as well as its leader.

It was natural that with his departure for the construction of the Federal State to entrust on his Crown Prince the bulk of the burden of development in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi then the responsibility of tasks, on 2 /2 /1969 he assumed the tasks of the Department of Defense in Abu Dhabi and on 1 /7 /1971 he served as Prime Minister of Abu Dhabi in addition to assuming the defense and finance affairs.

The Federal State

With the State of the Union and its independence in the second of December in 1971, the functions of His Highness Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan expanded, he undertook in addition to his positions within the local context in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi, the first federal post with his appointment as vice-president of the Federal Cabinet, a post meant a lot in a country that needs a comprehensive build, ranging from the political structure which was surrounded by several regional challenges through economic development which was besieged by a lack of resources and ending by social development that needs the efforts and human resources which were not available.

However, the new role with the magnitude of his responsibilities did not diminish the enthusiasm or the role of His Highness Sheikh Khalifa to work within the local context of the Emirate of Abu Dhabi, he says:





«The construction will stimulates him with a great pleasure and spurs more giving and tender», so he accomplished reorganization of the governmental body in the emirate in line with the establishment of the Federal State, so he canceled the local Council of Ministers, and an Executive Council for the Emirate was established and Highness took its presidency on 20 /2 /1974.

Under this regulation, some fields have been identified that are supervised locally with the annexation of certain facilities and services for the local federal government, this organization has contributed to achieve a double objective is to strengthen the federal entity, with the deployment of the umbrella of this entity to include some local facilities, it also kept the type of decentralization in the management of certain daily affairs.

The distribution of tasks between local and federal has reflected on the role of HH Sheikh Khalifa in the life of the UAE, Coming from the role of Abu Dhabi Emirate the largest among her sisters in the Union, and with the biggest resources, it was responsible to create and manage many of the federal institutions and to disburse on them which led to more responsibility aside from the responsibilities entrusted on HH in leading the local affairs of the emirate in the form of important aspects of the march of the Federal Labor.

Those tasks remained standing until he left his federal tasks as deputy chairman of the Federal Cabinet in 1974 and returned in 1976 to fill this time the position of Deputy Supreme Commander of the Armed Forces of the United Arab Emirates following the historic decision taken by the Supreme Council of the Federation of the integration of the armed forces under one command and one flag, to assume the task of building these forces...

The achievements made in building the federal armed forces has formed an important page in the history of the UAE as the balanced nature of the foreign policy of the UAE and its keen to weave good relations to its regional, Arab and international environment, made it a country without animosity, which resulted in a different role of the UAE Armed Forces away from the traditional role of armies.

The attention of His Highness Sheikh Khalifa was based on making the military institute a large multi-disciplinary where cadres of trained human resources are prepared, so numerous faculties of military were established which included in addition to educational institutions colleges of aviation and marine and other, the UAE troops and its institutions, in ten years has become a source of many of the leaderships that did not remain its role in the state limited to the military life, but spread in all civil action as well.






This trait which the UAE military institution enjoyed can return to the vision and philosophy of Sheikh Khalifa upon which he built this institution, it is as much as what it gives of importance to build this institution and its development commensurate with the role that it was built for, it gives importance same to the building of the state of various different and institutions.

His Highness said: «The state-building is a double process, it is building of power and power of building, so that the

construction of the army goes hand in hand and in perfect equilibrium with the construction process of civilization».



Beginning of Career

His Highness assumed his constitutional and federal powers as the President of the State, and became the ruler of the Emirate of Abu Dhabi on the third of November 2004, succeeding his father, «the late, may God have mercy on him» Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, who passed away in the second of November 2004

However, his career began much earlier, where HH accompanied his fathers march in its all stages and the first official position he occupied was as «Rulers Representative in the Eastern Region and Chairman of the courts» in September 18, 1966, and this position had great importance in his life and during his stay in Al Ain His Highness had the ample opportunity for daily contact with citizens and to look at their

situations and to identify their aspirations and hopes.

He was appointed as Crown Prince of Abu Dhabi in the first of February 1969 and Chairman of the Department of Defense; he took over the leadership of the Defense Force in the emirate and has played a key role in its development and transfer it from a small guard force into a multiple tasks force with modern equipment.

In the first of July 1971, His Highness Sheikh Khalifa was the president of the first Local Council of Ministers of the Emirate of Abu Dhabi as well as the posts of defense and finance in this Council.

After the announcement of the Federal State, His Highness, in addition to his local responsibilities, became the Vice President of the Council of Ministers in the Federal Government which was formed in December 1973.

In February 1974 after the cancellation of the local cabinet, His Highness became the first President of the Executive Council, which replaced the Council of Ministers of the emirate in all its responsibilities.

During his presidency of the Executive Council, he oversaw the development projects and modernization witnessed by the whole emirate, he also supervised the so-called negotiations of oil participation which re-formulated the oil policy and laid the groundwork for a more just and equitable relationship with the



operating oil companies, and in order to follow-up this role, His Highness assumed the presidency of the Supreme Petroleum Council, a position he still holds so far.

The Supreme Petroleum Council, the foremost authority in the relationship with oil companies operating in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi; it is also considered as a supervisor on the policy of the petroleum industry in the emirate in the form of excavation, organization and production.

In addition to his responsibilities at the head of the Executive Council, His Highness in 1976 established an was the president of the Abu Dhabi Investment Authority, which oversees the management of financial investments of the Emirate within the strategic vision for the development of financial resources and to maintain stable sources of income for future generations, this Authority has contributed, thanks to His Highness> leadership and follow-up, to the training and rehabilitation of a selection of national cadres, who have assumed senior positions in government agencies, whether federal or local.

Khalifa Committee is a development initiative contributed to the equitable distribution of wealth to citizens.

Development initiative

One of the key initiatives of his development which left profound social impact was the establishment of the Department of Social Services and Commercial Buildings, which among the people was known as, «the Committee of Sheikh Khalifa,» the activities of this department has translated a philosophical and deep concept in the distribution of wealth to the citizens, where it delivered generous funding to citizens without any benefits, to create and establish commercial buildings will yield financial returns periodically.

This has contributed to increase the income of citizens and enhancing their economic and social position on one hand, and assisted in the prosperity of the construction boom in the country on the other hand, and the total investment in the projects carried out by this department since its establishment in 1981 reached more than 35 billion dirhams through which more than 6 thousand residential towers and modern shopping malls have been completed in Abu Dhabi and Al Ain and other areas in the emirate.

The departure of His Highness for the management of local affairs in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi did not

prevent him from contributing to Federal Tasks and Affairs in addition to the role he played at the Union through his position as Deputy Prime Minister.

His Highness assumed the position of Deputy Supreme Commander of the Armed Forces after the historic decision of the Supreme Council of the Union in May 1976, of the integration of local defense forces in each of the Emirates of the Union under the umbrella of one leadership and the defense affairs became among the exclusive responsibilities of the State.

Through his position as deputy commander of the armed forces, His Highness has shown great care and growing interest in the armed forces which during that period witnessed a big jump in terms of processing, training and capacity to absorb new technologies and methods developed by His Highness> keenness to provide to all sectors of all troops.

The contribution of His Highness is accounted for in the formulation of military genius which is derived from the highest political constants of the state based on a policy of moderation and non-interference in the affairs of others and respect for mutual interests, in the light of these constants His Highness worked on the formulation of defensive policy is based on the maintenance of independence and state sovereignty and its interests.

This policy has contributed to putting the UAE Armed Forces in an advanced position gained respect of the world, especially after giving these forces a number of international missions in the framework of the United Nations, such as participating in the peacekeeping forces in Kosovo and the delivery of relief and humanitarian aid to many countries and was the most prominent of which to help Lebanon to remove the mines left behind by the Israeli occupation of southern Lebanon after its withdrawal.

His Highness has given during his presidency of the Executive Council of the Emirate of Abu Dhabi a great attention to development projects and modernization and updating of infrastructure and facilities of different services and work on building a modern administrative and integrated legislative system as the basis for the process of economic and social development.

After taking the reins of the presidency, His Highness unleashed an initiative to develop the experience of the legislative authority, to modify the method of selecting members of the Federal National Council so that it gathers between election and appointment as a first step, which offers ultimately the selection of Council members through direct elections.





Preserving the heritage of his ancestors is a responsibility His Highness maintains to deepen in the new generations.

Features and Hobbies

His Highness is well known for his punctuality, and commitment to a strict daily work program distributed among many official tasks performed by His Highness, and during meetings with the citizens is also known as a good listener, he is characterized by genteel, humility in his dealings with others, which earned him the love and respect of the citizens, he is also mild-mannered, reader of history and lover for poetry and literature.

His Highness exercises a number of hobbies, he likes fishing, and is skillful in falconry, which he gained from his father, the late Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, and during his interest in this stimulating sport, His Highness contributed and personally-sponsored programs and projects to preserve the natural environment in the fishing areas on top of which is the liberation of hawks by returning them back into their natural environment, at the end of each hunting season and breeding Houbara, which is a favorite prey for hawks and release them in the wild, and sponsor research on the movement and migrations of birds using space technology.

The contributions of His Highness in this area

received international recognition in more than one occasion and forum, and his role in the preservation of the environment in the hunting areas yielded a number of relations of personal friendship with leaders of countries that are well-known as hunting areas especially in the countries of Central Asia.

His Highness cares about his follow-up of various sports activities in the State, especially football, as His Highness is keen to sponsor and attend major sporting activities as well as honoring local sports teams which have made local, regional or international achievements or tournaments,.

His Highness also pays special attention to the environmental work as the environmental work becomes one of the fundamental determinants of development projects and an essential part of the legislative system and government policies which was reflected in the appointment of a specialized Minister of the Environment in the first government formed in his reign.

Head of State

In the fourth quarter of 2004, the Wise of Arab Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, may God have mercy on



him, passed away, and with his departure the UAE and its people has lost a dignified and generous father and the Arabs and the world have lost a leader, so all the eyes and hearts headed to the rising State to find out who will be handed over its leadership, it was not long to wait where the Elders UAE and the elderly members and Sheikhs of the Supreme Council of the Union are called to meet in Al Bateen Palace at Abu Dhabi to discuss the matter and resolve it.

This historic meeting was headed and chaired by the late Sheikh Maktoum bin Rashid Al Maktoum, in his capacity as Vice-President and Prime Minister and Ruler of Dubai and attended by the rulers of the emirates, they agreed on the election of His Highness Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Ruler of Abu Dhabi Emirate as President of the United Arab Emirates.

They issued a statement to announce their decision to the public, and where it says « under article 51 of the permanent constitution, His Highness Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Ruler of Abu Dhabi was unanimously elected as the President of the United Arab Emirates, succeeding the late deceased, Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan».

The Council expressed its full confidence that the people of the UAE will be as Zayed always wanted a guard of the Union and its great achievements at all levels, calling God to include His Highness Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan, into His great care and to bless him to succeed in serving the nation and the dear people of the UAE.

His Highness Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan expressed his appreciation for the precious confidence placed in him by his brothers Their Highnesses Rulers of the Emirates, stressing his determination to continue to work upon the leader's approach and to follow his cooperation and solidarity with his brothers Their Highnesses Supreme Council Members in order to promote the Federal march and all that is booming UAE, its stability and welfare of its people.

Powers entrusted to the Head of State

- Sign the credentials of diplomatic representatives of States and foreign bodies and accept the adoption of the diplomatic and consular representatives of foreign states to the Union and receive their credentials, he will also sign documents of appointment of representatives and their patents
- Oversees the implementation of laws, decrees and the Federal decisions made by the Council of Ministers and the ministers concerned
- exercises the right to pardon or commutation of sentences and approve death sentences, in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution and federal laws
- Conferring decorations and medals of honor, both military and civil, in accordance with the laws relating to such decorations and medals

More than 15,000 persons shall benefit from the traffic awareness points last month

Around 15076 persons benefited from the traffic awareness points organized by Traffic & Patrol Department of Abu Dhabi Police; in conjunction with Saaed Association, during last August. It included 128 sites for "Education Patrols" on internal roads and highways, in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi. Around 27423 persons benefited from 373 lectures in traffic awareness during the first quarter of the current year, to enhance the traffic safety within the community, with the focus on youth.

Lt. Col. Jamal Salem Al Amery – Head of Public Relation Section said that the traffic awareness plan implemented by the Traffic & Patrol Dept. was part of the initiative by H.H. Sheikha Fatima Bint Mubarak (Mother of Emirates) Chairperson of the Women General Association, Supreme Chairperson of the Family Development Foundation and Chairperson of Motherhood & Childhood Supreme Council.

Al Amery indicated that the Department together with Saeed and support by the Education Patrols organized a lecture on traffic awareness at Glenelg School to improve the traffic culture among the students and to confirm that the public road is not a playground and to urge

the youth not to play with the bicycles and football on roads. It also meant to teach them about the traffic signals and to cross the roads with the adults and to be seated onboard the buses. Children below 10 should be seated at the back with the seatbelts fastened. Gifts were distributed to them.

Al Amery confirmed that the traffic awareness could be intensified through the community communication, support by the Traffic Patrols and various interaction awareness programs. This would change the negative attitude of some of the road users, in accordance with accidents and offences indications.



Saced urges the motorists to drive carefully in the foggy weather

To reduce the traffic accident Saaed Association of Prevention of Traffic urged the motorists to drive carefully in foggy weather conditions to avoid making accidents because of the low visibility.

A total number of ten traffic accidents was reported, two with serious injuries, 4 medium accidents and 4 minor accidents during the 4th quarter of 2011.

Safe Driving

Saeed said that the safe driving under all conditions is a requirement for the road safety and helps to avoid the traffic accidents. Saeed added that the traffic rules and speed limits should be strictly adhered to an internal roads and highways.

Some specialists said that: "Fog is the condensation of air carried water vapor into small dews to form a cloud with a ground base. The fog is formed as the result of the weather on the high and low atmosphere due to the elevation at both layers which subdues the wind and increase the humidity.

Leaving Safe Distance

Saaed Association of Prevention of Traffic advised the motorists to leave safe distance, not to overtake and reduce speed at the time of fog. They must switch on the lights, not to use the mobile phone and concentrate on driving. Saeed also urged them to follow-up with the awareness programs to enhance their traffic culture, to know the best and correct way in dealing with the fog, to listen to the weather forecast and the distance at which the horizontal visibility drops.

Monitor the Air Temperature

According to the scientific data "Fog forecasting depends on monitoring the air temperature and comparing it with the mist. When the two readings are close to each other there is a high possibility for high fog. The beginning of fog is monitored by using the satellites through a certain frequency.

The air movement and speed should also be studied. As the speed increased the air mixture process with the layers close to the surface shall also increase, hence there is a less chance for fog and vice versa.

Saaed Society organizes 15 field visits to Abu Dhabi Schools



Saaed is a public utility organization which operates with clear vision focusing on protection from accidents

Within its awareness programs Saaed organized 15 field visits for the students to the schools in Abu Dhabi City during the first week of the new school year. This is a part of a comprehensive traffic awareness plan within a strategic partnership with the Traffic & Patrols Dept. to support the community communication approach.

The Traffic Awareness Team of Saaed stated that the awareness programs focused on providing interactive activities and lectures to the students, drivers and supervisors of the schools buses.

Community Responsibility

The Awareness Team said that the programs considered the traffic awareness of the students as a community responsibility to protect them from the road accidents by the compliance of the drivers with the traffic rules and not to allow the children below ten to sit on the front seats and not to leave the car engine running and by avoiding improper parking.

Ensure Safe Parking

The Awareness Team urged the school bus drivers

to ensure a safe parking at the students pick-up and drop-off locations and ensure that no student is standing behind the bus.

Abide by the Ethics

Students are urged to abide by the ethics and seating instructions on buses. They should stand on board, not to extend hands on heads through the windows, not to litter through the windows and stay 10 steps away during the pick-up and drop-off.

He said that the Saaed Society issued the third edition of Saeed Magazine which included a number of traffic articles, prepared by experts and specialists in traffic culture. The fourth edition is in the process.

The Awareness Team stated the society is one of the public utility organizations, operates by clear vision focusing on the protection from the traffic accidents and their human and financial losses which affect all aspects of life. He urged to enhance the community role in supporting the official efforts in the traffic safety.





As of September the prohibition of the sale of used tires has become effective and a fine of Dhs. 100 thousand shall be imposed upon violation by the importers dealers.

The Ministry of Economy granted a grace period of six months to the dealer to adjust their status. The decision aims at improving the specification and quality of the national products and those traded in locally and within the region; to provide safety, health, environment and consumer protection.

Control of Tires

The Technical Regulation controls all types of tires compliant with UAE standard specifications including the sport cards, salon cars, buses, truck, trailers and motorbikes, with the exception to the agriculture and industrial equipment and machines, because there used off the public roads and highways conditions of Tires storage.

The warehouses should be consisted with the UAE and gulf standard specifications so as to affect the tires quality and to prevent the import tires which are not compliant with the UAE standard specifications, in cooperation with the local and federal control authorities.

Mr. Moh'd Saleh Badry, Acting Director General of Emirates Specification & Metrology Authority said in a press conference: "All the tires shops are liable to abide by the decision. They were granted a grace period of 6 months to adjust their status." He said that the Authority would give conformance certificates to tires not include in the Gulf system such as the motorbikes tires, the agricultural and race tires, provided that the importer shall provide a Lab Test Report from an approved laboratory. He considered that as part of the Authority procedures in applying the control regulations to the local factories of recycled tires. There shall be a mechanism in taking and testing samples to evaluate the conformity and ensure that all the tires companies are abiding by the technical regulation of tires control.

Tires Conformity

He said that the Authority worked with a number of concerned authorities in ensuring the tires conformity and safety during the technical inspection of vehicles and control of shops and stores of new tires.



At your service

Dhs. 400 and 4 black points for the offense keeping the children at the back seat secured their safety

Some of the parents keep their children on the front seat while taking them to schools. This may cause accidents as the result of the driver's distraction.

Some parents compromise of the safety and security of their children by allowing the children below 10 to sit on the front seat which may result in tragic accidents causing serious injuries or even death.

Parents must teach their children how to embark and disembark from the vehicles, how to sit on the seats, use the safety belt or sitting on the backseat. Children below ten years should not be allowed to sit on the front seat as the safety belt cannot be used for their small bodies and hence they may be exposed to accidents. The driver may also be distracted. Some specialists said that the vulnerability of the children to injuries could be less if they sit on the children seats on the back seats or use any other types of stabilization and not only the safety belt.

The traffic offenses list states that Dhs. 400 fine and 4 black points shall be imposed if the children below 10 years of age is allowed to site on the front seat.

Traffic Accidents Control Conference, recommends to include the Traffic Awareness in the schools curricula

The participants in the AGCC Traffic Accident Control Conference recommended to including the traffic awareness and education and best practices in the school curricula.

They also recommended not being lenient with the offenders and developing the traffic awareness by using the media and modern technology.

International & Regional Participation

Dubai host the conference that witnessed wide regional and international participation by the authorities and organizations concerned with the traffic safety and protection from road accidents, including the "Insurance" and "Transport" organizations.

Safety Belt

The participants reasserted the importance of using the safety belts. They urged to keep the children on basic seats and to change the attitude and habits which contradict with the rules of proper driving or the best use of roads. They also insisted on



continuing the efforts to reduce the traffic accidents in the region and cooperate with government and private organization to design the awareness programs and plans.

Development of Driving Schools

The recommendations referred the importance of the development of the driving schools by designing the traffic awareness programs and plans with clear objectives, review the punishment and the offence system. It was also necessary to organize an annual conference for the AGC countries and give priority to the development plans to ensure equal and strict implementation of the Traffic Rules. It was also recommended to involve the private sector and the civil community in making the traffic safety action plans.

The participants said that the involvement of youth and solving the traffic accident issues are very important. They also focused on the importance of the development plans for the strict implementation of the traffic rules, building the databases, exchange information and using practices of the road safety. They demanded to regularly exchange best practices, through periodicals, prints and internet regarding the traffic safety. They also agreed on the importance of developing strategies for the role of all means of media in spreading awareness and traffic culture. They confirmed the importance of the role played by the community organizations and initiatives and to highlight the community role and responsibility in spreading traffic awareness and the adoption of more studies in the traffic safety by the scientific, academic and research institutions.

Concept of Traffic Culture

The discussions by the participants at the conference addressed the spread of the concepts of traffic culture indicating that many problems resulted from the wrong use of the means of transport leading to increasing the number of accidents resulting in human casualties, damage of property and assets.

Well prepared for the New School Year

"Abu Dhabi Traffe": Proper traffic and making the students and individuals aware of the road safety

The traffic flow has been very smooth on all the roads within Abu Dhabi Emirate on the first day of all the new school year. No accidents were reported, while the drivers and students have been very cooperative with the traffic personnel which helped to keep the smooth flow of traffic.

Abu Dhabi Police deployed 120 patrols to provide safety traffic to the students, individuals, ambulance and rescue cars at locations near to schools, to quickly respond to any emergency case in Abu Dhabi, Al Ain and the Western Region.

Traffic & Patrols Department was fully prepared and ready to ensure the safety of students and other road users and to make the roads a safety environment and accidents – free. This could be achieved by complying with the speed limits, careful driving and slowing down near the schools.

Such preparations were accompanied by organizing awareness programs for the students, teachers and drivers, which also included lectures, competitions, visits and traffic safety awards, to encourage them to participate in making the school year free of accidents.

Brig. Eng. Hussein Ahmed Al Harthy – Director of the Traffic & Patrols Dept. urged the drivers of the school buses to us the safe bus stands and provide an ample time in the students pick-up and drop-off, to take their seats before moving and to safely leave the bus before moving.

He also urged the parents to safety drive to schools, be careful while driving and not to keep the children below ten on the front seats or allow them to cross the streets and roads alone so as to avoid the run-over accidents.

He also urged them not to part at random at the schools in the morning and at the end of the school day, because this would obstruct the traffic flow. He also emphasized the students compliance with the instructions of searing on buses, not to stand onboard, extend hands and heads through the windows, hot to litter through the windows and stay 10 steps away from the bus upon embark and disembark and not to disturb the driver.

He said that the Department organized many awareness programs for the school students. "Schools Free of Accidents" competition was organized last year to encourage the students to provide creative ideas about the traffic awareness, which would have a good effect on providing the traffic safety to the students and make use of their works in the traffic awareness plans of Abu Dhabi Police.

The competition also included the teachers, parents, bus supervisors and watchmen at the government schools at the kindergartens and elementary levels.

He added that the Department had organized traffic educating villages at certain schools, within the awareness programs, to instill the traffic culture in the soul of students. It included traffic dummies, traffic signals to reach them how to respect the traffic rules, to ensure their safety as well as the safety of others.

The directors and staff at the schools and transport organizations were also urged to ensure the mechanical safety of their buses so as to avoid the accidents. The drivers and supervisors must watch the students while leaving the bus and check the bus to ensure that no one is left behind before parking.

Al Dhahri: Abu Dhabi Education Council cares for the enhancement of traffic culture

The Executive Director of School Operations Sector at Abu Dhabi Education Council, Mr. Mohamed Salem Al Dhahri said that they are keen to bring up a generation that respects the traffic rules and enable them to be aware of the traffic culture and how to deal with the road.

He said that the Council focuses on the quality of students in various traffic issues through lectures and awareness programs organized in cooperation with Abu Dhabi Police to enhance their traffic culture. Religious lectures are organized in coordination with the Islamic



"Abu Dhabi Urban Planning Council" launched the updated Manual for the design of modern streets in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi. The new version of the Manual included the amendments as the result of researches and analysis by the Council for upgrading the existing streets and intersections. It also included technical guidelines for the designers of road networks to support the safety rates at the residential areas. The new version of the Manual was announced at meeting held in the Emirates Palace Hotels for this purpose.

The Manual new version focuses on reducing the dependency on private cars within Abu Dhabi Emirate, by designing streets to achieve the balance between the needs of the road users and the safety of pedestrians. Also to lay down basics for complete designs of the means of public transport.

Eng. Amer Al Hammady, Executive Director of

Planning & Infrastructure at Abu Dhabi Urban Planning Council said: "The aim of the Modern Streets Design Manual is to change the present concept of the urban streets to streets depend on providing transport and environment with many options which is pedestrians friendly so that our streets shall become a model for urban streets."



He added: "We like to see a transformation from inactive streets to active public places and from congested streets with no public places to sustainable streets with a balanced design, that welcome the public and support the socio-economic activities.

The Urban Planning Council prepared and updated a Manual for the design of urban streets in cooperation with the Department of Transport, Department of Municipal Affairs, the three Municipalities, Abu Dhabi Police, Civil Defense – Abu Dhabi and Health Authority in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi and other concerned authorities.

It is possible to apply the technical and guiding aspects in the Manual to Emirate of Abu Dhabi streets including the current and future areas. It gives due care to the appearance of the streets and provide the designers with the necessary tools to ensure that all the elements located between the pavement and

building elevations are in place and with the correct size.

The Manual asserts the necessity to provide pedestrian crossing very of obstacles. It obligates the designers to select the most suitable places for the streets lights, traffic signals, services boxes, seats, plants in the design of the new streets. Abu Dhabi Urban Planning Council added to the updated version of the Manual an electronic design software to help the users to develop the street sections and horizontal elevations.

The software provides the necessary directions for the design of new streets revise and redesign the existing streets.

The electronic design software provides a simplified source to the designers to help them to take quick decisions related to the preparation of streets and normal sections.

61 distinguished services provided by the Federal Traffic & Licensing System

The federal traffic & Licensing System provides 61 services to the public. Now all the transaction are electronically processed by the public of their homes, regardless of the original location of the transaction process. The system includes the unification of the data at all traffic & Licensing Departments, throughout the state to provide an easy access to the registered vehicles and cars information.

The system enables to pay the fitness and renew the registration books and driver's licenses or to obtain the ownership certificates, transfer and export licenses to any other Traffic & Licensing Department or services center.

It has been noted that this system was gradually in 2006 throughout the country. The system also ensures the safety and security and with a mechanism to control the data entry to suit the traffic requirements in each emirates.

Main Software

The Ministry of Interior launched this system which consisted of main software's. These re: Driver test, Drivers licenses, vehicles licensing, traffic files, traffic fines, traffic accidents. The system also included additional services such as the projects car lease, axial weights, documents file, traffic courts and electronic services related to the traffic files and services for both the public and companies.

The system was installed by the Ministry of Interior Abu Dhabi Police, G.H.Q., Dubai roads & Transport Authority, Dubai Police G.H.Q. and other police departments in U.A.E. to provide the services to the public of their places.

The system operates through am integral work system consisting of the software and electronic service. This also include unified database of the ministry which contains all the information such s the traffic files, driver's license, vehicles registration

and traffic fines. The system helps in achieving the E-government service through integration with the other related government departments and agencies.

The public and companies can follow up their traffic transaction, pay the fines, renew the registration books, driver's license, and obtain the ownership certificates, export and transfer to any other Traffic Department or a service center throughout the country, regardless of the original place of service.

Though the system the procedure at the Traffic Departments is unified and the electronic checking of information is available to avoid any human errors, thus the paper work is done with.

The issuance of the new registration books of the vehicles has been unified with high quality specifications as to accuracy and confidentiality and in accordance with the international quality standards. All the vehicles and drivers licenses are issued through the unified system. The new registration book provides absolute confidentiality accuracy and safety and cannot be falsified thanks to the golden lines at the back with the micro particles.

Database

The system is provided with a unified database, containing all the basic information that copes with the Ministry of Interior strategy in using the latest technology and improving the services provided to the public.



The Ministry of Interior called upon the public and the public companies, to benefit from the electronic services provided to them through the internet and though the electronic response and payment systems. The fines and the process of any transaction can be affected from any emirate and with any employee as well as the renewal of registration or the driver's license, without the need for the paper work in future.

The system is also interfaced with external agencies such as the Department of Finance, Customs Department, Emirates Transport, Emirates Petrol, Abu Dhabi Electronic Government, Emirates ID and the exchange of information with Dubai Road Authority, though the safe electronic passage.

The service is provided to the public though all the services centers which electronically interfaced with the insurance companies and the technical inspections. The electronic services is available though many portals, such as the internet, electronic payment systems, electronic inquiry and fines payments system.

The services also enable the individuals to inquire about their traffic codes and offenses and pay the fines online.

Offenses Information:

Though the system you can inquire about the offenses by using the Federal Traffic Code. The individual can have an access to inquire about the car and the traffic file by using the car number and the driver's license number.

According to the Ministry of Interior data and the Federal Traffic & Licensing System provides the user with a safe option to pay the fines by using the credit card and the electronic response services, (600533333) to inquire about the fines payment over the phone and the traffic offenses by using the traffic code or the car number plate or by the drivers license number.

The user can pay by the credit card and though the system the beneficiary can know the amount of fine and pay it.

The system sends the list of fines by fax and releases the payment receipts. The caller can listen to a detailed explanation of the vehicles registration and drivers license and the required documentation. The services are provided in Arabic and English languages.


Sewices provided by the Thaffic & Lifeensing System

The Traffic & Licensing System services include the registration, re-registration, renewal and transfer of ownership, replacement and change of the ownership details, vehicle color change, transfer within and outside the state, trip ticket, de registration, new number plate or replacement, change of the number, without Registration Certificate and certificate clearance.

The system also enables, to transfer the offense from the vehicle to a driver "temporary number Plate" an offense from a vehicle to the license "Rent a Car Offices" transfer of offense from the vehicle to the driver "Commercial", downloading the external offenses clearance — offences, administrative filing, buying the impoundment period new license, change of license, license renewal, addition of category, replacement of lost or damaged, data change, transfer or recovery of a license.

It also includes impoundment of number plates, renewal of number plates, fine payments, cancellation of fine payments, downloading the traffic fines, cancellation of downloading, change of the fine articles completion of the license particulars, change of the license particulars, change of the vehicle particulars, change of the fine number, registration of the traffic code priorities and the fine number priority.

The services also include the N.O.C. for the transfer of license, to Whom It may concern Certificate, cancellation of a category or license, change of license within the state, change of license from abroad, minor accidents, major accidents, with injuries accidents caused by unknown, transfer of vehicles and licenses in the state, vehicles de registration, issuance of a replacement for lost or damages registration book, a replacement for lost or damages driver's license and renewal of number plates booking.



Training manager at Emirates Driving School, Mr. Dino Kalivas stated that the Company provides service to more than 70,000 people per year, through its Abu Dhabi Branch, together with another three branches in Al Ain, Tarif and Delma Island.

He was quoted as saying that the Company is one of the largest driving learning schools in the United Arab Emirates. It helps in the improvement and spread of traffic awareness among the motorists who use the local roads. The Company applied the quality management system and has been keen to continuously develop it, guided by the standards of ISO 9001:2008.

The Company offers a set of training programs such as: Theoretical Training in salon, heavy vehicles, buses and motorbikes. He also disclosed that

the company intends to launch a practical training in heavy vehicles, buses, light and heavy equipment (such as forklifts, rigs, cranes) and motorbikes.

He also said that the company is in the process to launch desert driving training (4x4) and develop a set of training programs for the companies drivers, who are engaged in sectors like oil, gas and transport. The Company is now working on the development of defensive driving to satisfy the client needs.

Mr. Kalivas continued: The Ministry of Interior in cooperation with Emirates Driving Company have developed special training programs for the traffic black points violators, with the aim to educate the violators who crossed or about to cross the black points limits. The program allows those drivers to attend the educating and awareness courses to be learn how to drive better and safer. As

soon as they successfully pass the course they can reduce the number of the black points.

As to the training approaches, Emirates Driving Co. depends on an approach to provide effective learning and practical training to meet the license equipments of Abu Dhabi Police. He explained that the courses are approved by the Swedish National Roads

Authority, specialized in training and consultancy in the Kingdom of Sweden. He asserted that the company priority is to provide training courses (theoretical and practical) with high quality by using the state-of-the-art technology in training such the simulation and tower training system

With regard to the company efforts in the enhancement

of traffic safety and programs approval, Mr. Kalivas said that the best international practices in the traffic safety, require a set of factors to reduce the casualties on roads, such as the road rules. learning and training (including the traffic awareness campaigns) a suitable and safe environment (by using safer vehicles and roads). He added that it is possible to reduce the traffic accident rates by improving the driving skills and introducing the traffic safety culture in the schools, retrain the drivers by creating the safe driving culture. He emphasized the comprehensive approach in training by focusing on the driver's mentality and not only the driver's "body" as expressed by him.

He said that the existing partnership between the company and the local community is a strategic priority of the company. partnership with community plays a substantial role in the management of safety on roads. He said the company was very proud of its strategic partners, in both the public and private sectors, Ministry of Interior, Abu Dhabi Police, Department of Transport, National Transport Authority, Emirates Transport, Emirates Youth Development Society and Abu Dhabi Chamber Commerce and Industry. Driving Company **Emirates** supports a number of traffic safety related committees, which include education, transport and tourism sectors, as an implementation of Abu Dhabi traffic safety strategy. It also supports a number of main traffic safety campaigns throughout the year such as the Gulf Traffic Week, awareness



campaigns, organized by the Ministry of Interior, roads and traffic safety exhibition, and traffic safety schools and universities functions.

He also mentioned that there is a partnership with Baniyas Sports Club, as the company seeks to enhance the community traffic safety in the community by targeting the youth in their sports activities.

He stated that the aim of the practical training at Emirates Driving Co. is to enable the trainee to achieve acquire maximum skills through the consistency of the theoretical training with the practical.

The traffic safety studies in Australia indicated that the extensive practical training of the beginners under qualified instructors who enjoy long experience reduces the accident risks by 30%. (Source: Transport Accidents Committee). Victoria, Australia.

Mr. Kalivas said that the practical training in the company, includes the simulated driving, where the drivers is exposed to different situations, such as expecting the drivers mistakes, dangerous weather conditions (fog, rain and dust). He added that the "defensive driving" enables to deal with all conditions, roads and situations.

He continued to say that the practical training program through the control tower is considered as a landmark in the company activities. It allows the trainee to be trained alone, so as to gain a greater deal of self-confidence in order to reach a certain level of efficient driving. The trainee begins the training through the tower with the basic maneuvers of the most complicated driving situations, such as interaction with other vehicles at certain places, watching the overtaking, roundabouts and traffic signals. The driving is remotely controlled. The instructions by the tower



instructor shall be issued through the radio installed on the tower training vehicles.

According to the latest studies on traffic safety, there is a strong relationship between the training which focuses on the knowledge skills (such as beware of dangers and driver's safety) and the safe driving attitude. He indicated that the introduction of the modern technology and new training methods by the company is intended to develop such skills.

He said that the company has invested the training resources such as the simulators, overturn vehicle and sliding seat to enable the trainees to gain more understanding and sense of impact

by highlighting the low speeds and how they cause serious injuries.

About the company present and future plans he said that the company decided to invest in Abu Dhabi and Al Ain branches to satisfy the market new requirements in training on heavy vehicles, buses, 4-wheeled cars, equipment (light and heavy) and motorbikes. This in addition to providing different types of training such as the driving in motorbikes, protocols and defensive driving. The Company provided all the necessary facilities and services at both locations and also include additional customer services.

The Company is designing a new mechanism to gain highest

customer satisfaction to enable them to join the training courses online, as well as the theoretical training at many sites. The Company also seeks to improve the services in the Western Region and plans to open other branches at the remote areas.

According to the Road Accidents Committee (Victoria, Australia) during the practical training, the trainees are able to develop their skills, such as wearing the safety belt, vehicle basic safety systems, how to control the vehicle, comply with the traffic rules, then move forward to more complicated tasks which involved the estimation of distances in traffic and interaction with other vehicles.

Positive Results of the Traffic Safety Improvement Strategy Traffic Accidents Reduction by 21% in the Emirate within 6 months

The United Arab Emirates achieved positive results in reducing the traffic accident rates during the second quarter of 2012 by 12% compared to the same period in 2011.

This is a great achievement in the plans and programs of traffic accident reduction which aim to make the people aware of the road dangers, safety driving, general safety conditions on roads and control by the traffic patrols.

Reduction of Accident Rates

According to the Ministry of Interior published data, the rate of deaths caused by traffic accidents during the second half of the current year reduced by 21.3% to around 310 cases compared to 394 during the same period in 2011.

Injuries dropped by 9.9% to 3818 compared to 4113 injuries within the same period of the last year. The traffic accidents dropped to 5.6% representing 3261 compared to 453 in the period of last year.

amounting to 2291 compared to 2321 accidents during the last year. The overturn accidents were reduced to 10.7% amounting to 342 in the first half of the current year compared to the same in 2011.

Run-over Accidents

There is a reduction by 15.8% amounting to 595 compared to 707 in the last year. The sudden causes leading to 524 accident at the rate of 16.07% followed by the offending "the sufficient distance" which caused 403 accident at the rate of 12.36%.

The "Negligence and lack of attention" offense caused 378 accidents at the rate of 11.59% followed by "Lack of judgment" which caused 293 accidents, then "Non-abidance by the lane" causing 262 accidents, "Crossing the red signal" causing 245, while "Reckless entrance into the road" which causes 227 accidents and "Over speeding' with 153 accidents.

Ministry of Interior Strategy

The implementation of the Ministry of Interior strategy improved the traffic safety on road networks, the traffic initiatives and led to achieving positive results in reducing the accidents in a partnership with the concerned sectors with the road safety.

The car coalition accidents were reduced by 1.3%
