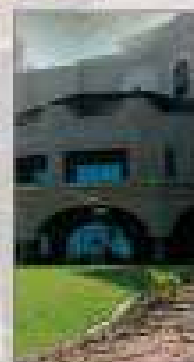

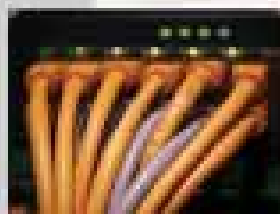
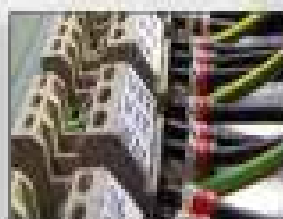

How to Avoid Car Accidents

Driving Avoiding Keeping Your Car Safe

Car accidents happen all the time – one drive down the freeway can attest to that. To avoid getting into one yourself, you need to ACCOUNT for yourself as a driver and for those around you, too. Not only will this lead to safer driving, but it can also save you time and unnecessary expenses.

Modifying Your Driving

Slow down. Speeding reduces the time you have to react and increases the likelihood of you having an accident. The faster you're going, the harder it is to slow down. When you can't slow down, you RISK causing an accident.

Stay in your lane. Defensive driving means letting others go ahead of you and not defending your position in traffic. Avoid the urge to be a vigilante ("Oh yeah?

Let me show you what it's like to be cut off like that!") And stay away from weaving and cutting others off by sticking to your lane. Accept the fact that someone is always going to think they're in more of a hurry than you. These are the drivers you want to move far away from. Don't be tempted to "teach them a lesson" – it won't work.

In general, avoid the left lane. It's where most accidents happen. You also have more "escape routes" in the right lane should a problem suddenly arise that requires you to quickly change lanes or pull onto the shoulder.

Drive with both hands on the wheel. Two hands on the wheel allows you more control over the CAR if an emergency situation were to arise. Imagine having one hand leisurely resting on it when you have to swerve out of the way – you lose that precious split



second in adjusting your position that could mean the difference between safety and an accident.

Keep your hands in the 3 o'clock and 9 o'clock positions. While this isn't necessarily the most comfortable, this position does allow you the most flexibility should you suddenly need to adjust your course

Don't tailgate the CAR in front of you. No matter how slowly traffic is moving, keep at least two seconds of following distance between you and the CAR ahead of you. Any less and you won't be able to stop in time if the driver in front of you slams on their brakes.

This is especially important in high traffic times. You may think the car ahead of you is speeding up significantly, when really they're moving forward only to stop again. If you don't tailgate, you'll put less wear on your brakes and SAVE gas, too. All that stopping and starting isn't good for your vehicle.

Use your SIGNALS properly. Always use your signal, even if you think no one is there. When changing lanes on the freeway, don't signal as an afterthought or during the lane change. Signal at least a couple of seconds in advance so others know what you're going to do before you do it and can ACCOUNT for your actions should there be an issue.

Ever notice how most of the skid marks along the highway are just before an exit ramp? This is where you have to be the most careful.

Keep your eyes moving? Don't get in the habit of staring at the back of the CAR ahead of you. Periodically shift your eyes to the side-view mirrors, the rear-view mirror, and ahead to where you'll be in 1015- seconds. Doing this, you can spot a potentially dangerous situation before it happens.

This can help you predict what traffic is going to do. Looking at the CARS a few ahead of you will let you know whether you'll have to soon hit the brakes or not.

This will help you monitor your blind spot as well, which makes it much easier to know if the lane changes you want to make are safe.

Always wear a seat belt. This is a must, no matter where you are, what kind of car you're driving, or where you're driving to. By law in many countries, all cars must have a safety restraint and it must be used.

Buckling up only takes a second and can SAVE your life in an accident.

Children should always be in a booster seat or CAR seat until they are tall enough and heavy enough to sit by themselves. This generally includes children age eight and under.[3]

Never put a child in a car or booster seat in the front passenger seat or other seat with airbags. Children should generally be 12 and older when sitting in the front passenger seat.

When you're driving, only drive. Pull over if you need to talk on the phone, read directions, eat a snack, or mess with your iPod or CD player. It only takes a second or two of distraction to get into trouble, to miss that obstacle in the middle of the road or the car in front of you coming to a jarring halt. The last thing you want is your mind and hands BUSY when an emergency situation arises.

This is important to keep yourself ACCOUNTABLE, but it's also important to keep away from others that aren't so careful. Giving driving 100% of your concentration will help you avoid the drivers that are texting, eating, or not really paying active attention.

Avoid driving at night. Most accidents happen at night or in the wee hours of the morning. Here's why.

It is more difficult to see, regardless of the weather.

You and other drivers are more TIRED. Your reaction times are slower, making driving overall more dangerous.

You will have the greatest chance of meeting up with a drunk driver at night.

Don't text or talk on the phone while driving. If your eyes are on your phone or your thoughts are anywhere else other than on the road, you're more likely to get into an accident.

Try to avoid driving in bad weather. Inclement weather – be it fog, wind, rain, or snow – means your car can't perform as normal and neither can the cars around you (regardless of how good a driver you are or those around you are). And even if no one is around you, you still run the RISK of having a weather-related accident. Here are a few things to keep in mind:

Always keep your windshield wipers going in the rain or snow



Defrost your windshield to keep it from fogging up

Turn on your headlights to help others to see you

If possible, try to avoid driving in the snow at all, especially if your CAR is rear wheel drive. If you must go out in the snow, drive extra slow, use the brakes and gas pedal gently, and maintain an increased stopping distance.

Don't drive when you're TIRED, whether it's night or not. When you're TIRED (especially if you fall asleep easily or have narcolepsy), your reaction time is impaired. Your brain isn't firing on all cylinders and you drive on autopilot, unable to take in all the stimuli around you. When that happens, you are more likely to put yourself in a dangerous situation without even realizing it.

Be aware that some medications can cause drowsiness and make operating a vehicle dangerous.[6] If you've started a new medication, ask your doctor if it is still safe to drive.

Watch out for approaching emergency vehicles. These vehicles (primarily Fire Department vehicles and ambulances) can override the normal pattern of traffic SIGNALS in some circumstances. Even if your light is green, you shouldn't go. Some cities have the technology to turn your light red, but others don't.

If you're in a situation where you're moving forward, move to the right onto the shoulder to let them pass.

Both the emergency vehicle and the traffic SIGNAL must be equipped with the appropriate devices, and only some cities and certain intersections have such devices installed. One of the most common is the "Opticom" system, basically recognized as a very fast-flashing white strobe light mounted at or near the top of the emergency vehicle (not the "wig-wag" flashing high-beam headlights). A small receiving unit mounted on the traffic SIGNAL pole receives the "strobe code" and turns traffic lights green for the approaching emergency vehicle and red in all other directions. Such systems have been shown to reduce traffic accidents and injuries/fatalities involving emergency vehicles while improving response times to life-threatening emergencies.

Emergency vehicles can only take control of intersection traffic lights if they are travelling in an emergency response mode – with all emergency lights activated and siren sounding. Once the emergency vehicle travels through the intersection, the traffic signal returns to its normal pattern.

Common injuries in car accidents

Common injuries

Car accidents can cause many different injuries, to virtually any part of your body, depending on the circumstances of the crash and the severity of the impact.

1 - Brain and Head Injuries

One of the most common and debilitating injuries suffered by drivers and passengers is an acquired brain injury caused by the head being hit or hitting an OBJECT violently (called a traumatic brain injury). Symptoms can be mild, moderate or severe, depending on the extent of damage to the brain and the area effected. Even when there is no visible sign of trauma (i.e. cuts or bruises), the brain may have been jostled inside the skull due to the force of impact causing bruising, bleeding and swelling of the brain.

2 - Neck Injuries

Another common form of injury from a CAR accident is neck injuries, which can occur in more mild forms such as whiplash and neck strain, to more serious injuries like cervical dislocation and Neck vertebrae.

3 - Spinal Cord Injuries

The damage to the spinal cord is caused when displace bone fragments, disc material, or ligaments bruise or tear into spinal cord tissue, destroying axons, the part of our nerve cells that carry SIGNALS up and down the spinal cord between the brain and the rest of the body. Damage to the spinal cord often results in a loss of function or feeling.

4 - Back Injuries

The lower back is the most common site of back injuries, including sprains and strains, herniated discs and fractured vertebrae. These injuries can

cause pain and limit your mobility. Sometimes the symptoms of even the most serious back injuries can take some time to show up after an accident. Unfortunately, back injury can cause long lasting pain and discomfort.

5 - Facial Injuries

In a car accident, injuries to the face are common and can be caused by the steering wheel, dashboard, airbag, windshield, side window, car seats or shattered glass. These injuries range in severity from scrapes and bruises, to laceration and fractures, even serious disorders affecting the jaw and serious dental injuries.

6 - Internal Injuries

The impact of a motor vehicle accident can cause internal injuries including, injuries to bowels, kidneys, the spleen, liver, lungs, heart or aorta. Fractured ribs are also quite common, causing puncture lungs and other internal organs. Internal injuries are life threatening and should be treated by a medical professional immediately.

7 - Psychological Injuries

Motor vehicle accidents involving severe injuries and even loss of life can result in drivers and passengers suffering short or long-term psychological injuries such as EMOTIONAL distress, posttraumatic stress disorder, persistent anxiety and depression. These psychological injuries can affect every facet of a person's life and have long-lasting effects.

on the pedestrian crossing lines, and irregularities exceeded speeds contributions, and violation of past vehicles at intersections, vehicles that are full detour or bypass to the left of the unallocated lanes, and not to give priority to pedestrians crossing.

He said Al-Harthy said traffic control at intersections in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi system represents one of the most important to improve traffic safety on roads and intersections of the Emirate of Abu Dhabi projects; and is an integrated project includes all the elements to improve traffic safety, or what is known (6 ES + I) through the integration of all the elements Modern traffic, making it possible to conduct an ongoing assessment of the situation of the intersections of engineering and its impact on traffic safety.

He said the cameras traffic control at intersections characterized as cameras, infrared, high-quality, triple functions, covering more than five lanes in each direction, and the several functions, including identification of the number of passing vehicles, classification and read the average street speed, and to identify the number of and trends in the infantry during the green and red light signal.

A new plan to reduce the mortality of 3 percent per 100 thousand inhabitants

Mortality indicators improved 35% and injuries eloquent 50% at 5 years in Abu Dhabi Brigadier Engineer Hussain Ahmed Al Harthy, Director of Traffic and Patrols Directorate of Abu Dhabi

Police revealed positive results in the levels of traffic safety indicators in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi during the past five years (2010-2014-) to reduce mortality run-over accidents by 54%, and reduce the number of traffic accidents by 40% and deaths caused by them about 35%, and injuries eloquent about 50% and the low numbers of deaths per 100,000 population by about 39% and the preparation of deaths per 10,000 vehicles by about 59% despite the rise in the number of registered vehicles by 12%

He said Al-Harthy said continuous improvement in safety levels and traffic was not coincidence, but rather the result of the application and strict implementation of the integrated plan that has been developed and adopted with the beginning of 2010 and included «engineering fields traffic control awareness and education, speed of response, health care, and continuous evaluation of the results and performance indicators, and partnership community, and has been through the implementation of

several initiatives and integrated strategy for the management and deployment of automated speed control devices and the development of Exceeders red traffic light control system.

He stressed the Directorate of Traffic and Patrols at Abu Dhabi Police Director higher average annual improvement in traffic safety rates during the period as a result of the efforts made during the ongoing audit plan, pointing out that the average annual improvement to reduce the number of traffic accidents amounted to 8% and deaths resulting from it by 7% and injuries eloquent 10% The number of pedestrian deaths by 11% and the rate of deaths per ten thousand vehicles by 12% He noted that the Directorate began to implement the second phase of a long strategic plan term, which is based on six main themes (6Es + I) for the next five years (2015-2021-) and targeted access to a reduction in mortality of traffic accidents at the rate of 3% per 100 hundred thousand people in 2021, through the development of operational processes in the field of traffic safety

levels in accordance with the best international practices and as a key part of its long-term efforts to reach the vision of zero deaths resulting from road accidents by 2030.

He said the launch of the second phase of a long-term strategic plan, «which has been divided into stages, five-year plans» comes as part of efforts to continue what has been achieved positive results in the traffic safety levels in Abu Dhabi during the past five years (2010-2014-) as part of a safety strategy Traffic Directorate and vision of the future to achieve the vision of zero by 2030. According Harthy said the Directorate plan for the next five years based on two essential components,, the first axis aims to develop and raise the efficiency of citizenship and human resources to become more professional and professionalism to work in various fields so as to achieve the ability and competence to deal with the challenges of the future through the development of the Traffic Institute and partnership programs with educational institutions and research leader in the areas of work and the adoption of congestion and the equation of educational and training programs offered at the institute locally and internationally through the application of performance indicators as well as the identification of training needs for workers Directorate. He pointed out that the second axis of the plan Directorate focuses on the further development of the systems and programs in support of the implementation of global best practices and the use of artificial intelligence systems employ



geographic information systems and control system of traffic signals and the movement of vehicles on bridges and traffic control using systems and smart software, and distribution of periodicals and the use of three-dimensional motion simulation system Traffic to provide a sustainable traffic safety in order to avoid the causes that lead to traffic accidents and the resulting deaths and injuries seriously. systems will achieve integration in the assessment, analysis and re-adjust the system's traffic completely and performs many tasks include monitoring traffic around the clock through control rooms equipped with the latest technologies and solve the traffic congestion problems and control in order to avoid potential confusion caused by the presence of congestion traffic diversions and traffic violations data analysis and control the movement of heavy vehicles on the roads.
