Khalifa: The UAE is great with its people, strong with its giving and achievements

His Highness Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan, President of the UAE, has emphasized that the leadership will stay the course laid down by the nation's founding fathers and continue to deepen the Spirit of the Union with a strong will that achieved glorious accomplishments and huge productivity bases and made changes to the course of history.

In a statement to Nation Shield journal on the occasion of the UAE's 46th National Day, The President, His Highness Sheikh Khalifa said that the prime job of the government is to make people happy; its mandate is to make the homeland a good place in which to live; its goal is to create an environment that revives hopes, to adopt policies that foster dreams, to launch projects that realize great expectations, to engage in actions that

make citizens feel safe and enjoy care, employment, education and housing.

His Highness Sheikh Khalifa extended his warm congratulations to His Highness Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice-President, Prime Minister of the UAE and Ruler of Dubai; His Highness Sheikh Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Crown Prince of Abu Dhabi and Deputy Supreme Commander of the UAE Armed Forces; and Their Highnesses the Supreme Council Members and Rulers of the Emirates, who are sharing their far-sighted vision in guiding a nation that is great with its people, proud of its values and principles, strong with its giving and its achievements.

As the nation is preparing to celebrate the «Year of Zayed» to mark 100 years since the birth of the founding father, Hi Highness Sheikh Khalifa invited all government entities and community forces to launch initiatives that deepen the noble values that Sheikh Zayed instilled in the people of the UAE so as to further encourage them to build and to give and to enhance their resilience to confront challenges. "Nations prosper by respecting and appreciating themselves, immortalizing their national figures and by committing to values of solidarity and participation. We also urge you to make the Year of Zayed a year for loyalty and belonging as well as for the enhancement



of creative and innovative practices which enable our state to become a pivotal actor regionally and globally," he said.

His Highness pointed to the enthusiastic response to the «Year of Giving» which was developed by the government and the private sector into a national strategy, which objectives were to promote humanitarian work practices in the country and deepen the traits of generosity and cohesion, which have set our people apart from others over centuries.

"Investment in human being has always been the essence of the vision for the development of our state since its establishment. Consequently, our focus is mainly directed towards fostering and supporting excellence and innovation and developing the capacities and skills of Emirati human resources. A development that is not human-oriented is doomed to failure," he added. "As a successful state, we believe that the prime job of the government is to make people happy; its mandate is to make the homeland a good place in which to live; its goal is to create an environment that revives hopes, to adopt policies that foster dreams, to launch projects that realize great expectations, to engage in actions that make citizens feel safe and enjoy care, employment, education and housing."

H.H the President continued: "For all these reasons, we recognize and appreciate cultural and human diversity, which we consider a key engine for sustainable development and a means for deepening the culture of openness, dialogue, communication and coexistence, and the denunciation of intolerance, extremism and intellectual isolation. To advance this approach, we launched the National Programme for Tolerance and created a ministry specifically for that purpose and also issued the Anti-Discriminatory Law, which criminalizes all forms of discrimination and hatred on the grounds of religion, creed, doctrine, sect, race, colour or language. We also issued a law to combat crimes of terrorism."

"Preparing for the future - near or far - starts today, not tomorrow. Out of this conviction, we approved in last October a cabinet reshuffle, which included unprecedented and qualitative portfolios, whose mandate is to prepare the country for the UAE Centennial Plan 2071 so as to become more capable and resilient to absorb the potential transformations over the next five decades and their implications in areas of businesses, jobs, services and the development of qualified manpower and excellent leaders," he added.



Sheikh Khalifa pointed out that the experiment has proven the soundness of the approach adopted by the UAE foreign policy since the establishment of the state, "which is characterized by an active vibrancy and presence at regional and international scenes to serve our national interests, to safeguard the state's sovereignty, to activate the GCC system, to advance efforts towards Arab integration and to contribute towards the emergence of a more just and fair international order in addition to positive participation in whatever effort that strengthens international cooperation to confront the common challenges."

Once again, H.H. Sheikh Khalifa called on the Iranian government to sit at the negotiating table for dialogue or to accept international arbitration to resolve the issue of our three occupied islands as part of efforts to maintain security and stability in the Arabian Gulf region since it is a top priority in the UAE policy. "We also renew our rejection of any foreign interference undermining our security or security and the stability of our brethren in the Kingdom of Bahrain, the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia or any other sisterly or friendly state," he emphasized.

His Highness also extended his profound gratitude to the armed forces and security agencies, confirming the relentless efforts to modernize and upgrade their capabilities and to take care of their personnel. "We also appreciate and salute our soldiers, officers and commanders for their dedication and devotion in performing their national duties and for their efforts to develop our defence and security capabilities. Thanks and appreciation also go to the loyal people of UAE for their solidarity and deep consciousness as well as to the expatriate residents from sisterly and friendly countries," he concluded.



In cooperation with Injazat Data Systems, SAAED for Traffic Systems has hoisted the UAE flag along with the


national anthem at the headquarters of the company at Injazat building in Abu Dhabi. All directors, managers and employees attended the ceremony.

Traffic awareness protection for the public against traffic accidents



Traffic awareness is considered as a protection for the public against traffic accidents according to the saying "prevention is better than cure", as traffic accidents cause much pain to those involved and their families leading to severe social problems as result of missing one of the parents or both due to lack of attention and commitment to traffic rules .

Seat belt might be one of the most important traffic safety means, as all scientific researches proved that it protects drivers and passengers from hurts during traffic accidents to the extent that is NOT believed by many.

Reviewing traffic statistics in different areas in the world, particularly for number of fatalities and serious injuries resulting from colliding with car's internal parts or being thrown outside of the car for those who don't use seatbelt, we'd see the credibility of all traffic legislations that affirm the use of seatbelt seeking the public safety.

In this context, it is worth to mention the proper way for using it; scientific researches stated that lower part of seatbelt should be around the pelvis not belly, particularly for pregnants; whereas the

upper part should be above the arm and collar bone towards the pelvis , not from beneath the arm , paying attention that drivers or passengers should be in upright position as seatbelt doesn't work efficiently if not so. Also , there shouldn't be a twist in any of the two parts of seatbelt ; it might severely hurt the user because twist in the belt presses very strongly on the area where it is especially the belly.

Seatbelt usage should be a second nature for all drivers and passengers and every user should advise others to use it by showing its benefits and importance in protecting themselves, families and friends.

There is no doubt that the UAE pays great efforts in this regards, through traffic awareness campaigns delivered by SAAD society and its magazine, public relations departments in traffic departments throughout the state and Traffic Institute in Al Ain city. Recent traffic legislations issued by ministry of Interior regarding the compulsion of driver and passengers to use the seatbelt is clear evidence to show that the state is very keen on maintaining public safety.

With the participation of international experts **Traffic Safety Conference discusses** education and training in traffic behaviour

Under the patronage of His Highness Sheikh Saif bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of the Interior, Major General Dr. Ahmed Naser Al Raisi, General Inspector of the Ministry of the Interior, inaugurated the International Conference on Traffic Safety under the title: The Impact of Education and Training on Traffic Behavior". Organized by the Emirates Traffic Safety Society at the Intercontinental Hotel in Abu Dhabi, the two-day conference will be held in participation with the International Organization for Road Accidents Prevention, Arab Road Safety Organization, World Health Organization (WHO) and the Secretariat General of the Gulf Cooperation Council.

Reduction

Statistics of the Ministry of the Interior revealed that traffic fatalities in the UAE decreased over the past six years from 826 deaths in 2010 down 12% to 725 deaths in 2016.

Traffic injuries also decreased 27% from 9,187 injuries in 2010 down to 6,681 injuries in 2016. Statistics also revealed that traffic accidents in the UAE during the same period were down 37% from 7,642 accidents in 2010 to 4,788 in 2016.

Education and Training

Mohammed Saleh bin Badwa Al Darmaki, Chairman of the Board of Directors for the Emirates Traffic Safety Society, said that the society was aware to tackle two important topics during the conference which are traffic education and training for their important role in shaping the personality of road users and enhancing their behavior. "Education and Training achieves safety for all and make from traffic safety culture an approach for all people in the society regardless of their age.



Al-Darmaki extended his thanks and appreciation to His Highness Sheikh Saif bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of the Interior and the Honorary President of the Emirates Traffic Safety Society, for sponsoring the conference, saying that this sponsorship affirms His Highness's continuous support to voluntary initiatives for the civil society of the UAE.

Claiming Souls

For her part, Dr Hala Sakr Regional Advisor on Violence and Injury Prevention and Disability at the WHO Middle East, said that traffic accidents are still one of



the main reasons of deaths today. The Global Status Report on Road Safety 2015 stated that road traffic injuries claim more than 1.2 million lives each year and have a huge impact on health and development. They are the leading cause of death among young people aged between 15 and 29 years.

In addition to deaths on the roads, up to 50 million people incur nonfatal injuries each year as a result of road traffic crashes and cost governments approximately 3% of their GDP.

Challenges

Dr Sakr pointed out that in Eastern Mediterranean Region, data points to a decrease in the number of traffic fatalities between 2010 and 2013. However, this rate remains higher that the global one, placing the region in the 2nd place after the African Region in traffic fatality rates. Most of fatalities in the region occur in the middle income countries.

Honorary Presidency

During the conference, Her Royal Highness Princess Abeer bint Abdullah bin Abdulaziz was chosen as the Honorary President of the Arab Road Safety Organization. She is the first woman to occupy this position in the history of the organization. Princess Abeer was chosen for this post considering her efforts in voluntary humanitarian work and her interest in traffic safety as well as spreading the culture of family traffic safety.

41K traffic fatalities in the Arab world

Afif al Fariqi, President of the Arab Road Safety Organization, revealed that traffic accidents caused the death of 41,000 persons in the Arab world in 2016 alone, whereas traffic injuries from those accidents were at 250,000 ones for the same period, pointing that this figure decreased 2.4% in 2017.

"The UAE is one of the pioneering countries in reducing traffic fatalities considering the flexibility in modifying traffic regulations and updating them regularly to cope with the increasing numbers of vehicles and residents in addition to having an advanced infrastructure," Al Fariqi said.

He pointed out that some Arab countries were successful in reducing traffic fatalities 50% this year, calling on countries to produce strict procedures to limit such accidents.

Hospitals and trade shops have come forward with generous donations for this initiative, donating hundreds of car seats for children in order to protect them from harm; they are also working on educating parents and care givers in order to ensure the safety of each child from the day they leave the hospital as a new born until they reach the legal age of which a car seat is no longer required.

Many parents are donating car seats themselves, handing them to the campaign officials at The Supreme Council for Motherhood and Childhood and at the Ministry of Interior. Other community members and entities have also responded positively to the campaign.

Abu Dhabi Police studying to employ AI to ensure pedestrians' safety



Abu Dhabi Police is studying to utilize Artificial Intelligence at pedestrian crossings to ensure the safety of pedestrians

Brigadier Ali Khalfan Al Daheri, Director of Operations Sectors, said that Abu Police are keen to use all available resources to improve the safety on roads in Abu Dhabi, including the application of Al. He highlighted the growing number of pedestrians on the streets of the capital as one of the main reasons for wanting to improve safety.

Al-Daheri stated that Abu Dhabi police is looking into ways to utilize AI in finding practical means that would ensure the safety of the community. He added that not giving the priority to pedestrians and not allowing enough safety space for stopping vehicles as well as jaywalking are all causes that require from us to use advanced tools to ensure their safety and to upgrade traffic safety systems.

Brigadier Eng. Nasser Sultan Ali Nasser Al Yabhouni, Director of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) Department at Abu Dhabi Police, said that main roads are the veins of vehicle movement in Abu Dhabi City and the new system will offer ease of safe movement, especially at peak hours.

He made clear that the study will focus on practical aspects of monitoring pedestrian crossings by trial analytical systems to specify the cases where AI is required to ensure traffic safety, limit negative sides and improving the general look of the city.

This study will include monitoring and organizing movement on pedestrian crossings by using two monitors: one for incoming traffic towards the pedestrian crossing, and one for pedestrians, and by using two cameras, one to read license plates and one for visual analysis. There will also be a central processing unit, a directional device and communication set to call the Monitoring and Control Center. The system will monitor the pedestrian crossing and its surroundings, which would allow vehicles and pedestrians to pass safely according to fine traffic guidelines.
