

Sheikh Zayed was born on 06 May 1918 in the Trucial States in the island of Abu Dhabi, which is called in such a name, according to folk stories, due to the abundance of "Dhabi" Gazelles on the island.

Sheikh Zayed was born during years of hardships; however, they did not take him down, on the contrary it shaped his personality as a leader amongst his people who were deprived of everything but of dignity and pride.

Sheikh Zayed was born and bred in Al-Hosn Palace, the seat of Abu Dhabi government, which was built by Sheikh Shakhbut the First in 1793 after moving to Abu Dhabi from Liwa.

Sheikh Sultan passed away in 1926 when Sheikh

Zayed was still in his early years. He moved to Al-Ain in an early stage of his life to assume the leadership afterword.

## **Eminent Personality**

Sheikh Zayed received his teaching from Abdullah bin Ghanim for two years; during his young age he pursued more education utilizing his own efforts. He learnt the Holy Quran and acquainted himself with the rules of Islamic Shar-



iaa. He gradually grew fond of the Holy Quran. Besides, he understood and learnt some Arab poetry such as the poems of al-Mutanabbi, Abi Tamam, and the rules of Nabati poetry and learnt about the values and customs of the Bedouin and gained the necessary skills of hunting, equestrianism and shooting.

As the time past, Sheikh Zayed grew to make an eminent personality features with wisdom, vision and patience. He worked very hard to shape





a leading personality and realized the basics of tribal balance and how to solve disputes and knew deep down that survival will remain the obsession of all tribes and that conflicts will not end until the general surrounding conditions change.

The star of Sheikh Zayed rose during the negotiations of Al-Buraimi borders dispute, when the people looked at him with respect and admiration.

## **Ruling Al-Ain**

In 1946, Shaikh Zayed became the ruler of Al Ain, the lack of water and funds did not stop him from developing the city. He drew a precise plan to invest in the capabilities of the city and worked hard on materializing the plan. His door was open to all his fellow citizens, they can say whatever they want, telling then that the ruler is one of them and does not live above them. During his time as the ruler of Al-Ain, the city transformed into a green heaven. Since he ruled Al-Ain City, Sheikh Zayed felt the need for a lot of work, and despite the lack of water, funds and capabilities, but that did not drove him to despair; he repaired the old water tunnels and dug new wells in order

to expand the agricultural lands including Al-Sarouj water tunnel in Al-Ain City.

Thanks to his directions, in 1956 the first school opened in Al Ain called "The Nahyania School", the first market, road network and medical clinic were also established. Perhaps the greatest achievement during such a difficult time in the country's history is reallocating the water's ownership to increase Al Ain's agricultural areas—despite the scarcity of water at that time—making it available to all. Sheikh Zayed worked on reforming works; he went through all the aspects of life until he was called "The Man of the Great Reform". Such reforms and accomplishments made from him the promised ruler to rule the Emirate of Abu Dhabi.

### Assuming Leadership

The al-Nahyan family unanimously chose Sheikh Zayed as the new Ruler of the Emirate on August 6, 1966. Since assuming the leadership, Sheikh Zayed organized a key development process programme and encouraged his people to be involved and participate wholeheartedly in the process, bringing in foreign expertise for sup-



port where necessary. A few days after assuming office, the establishment of a modern formal government with its Ministries and Departments was announced and the new Government entrusted with the task of conducting the affairs of the state.

Sheikh Zayed's priorities included building new roads, construction of a bridge to link Abu Dhabi Island to the mainland with the noise of machines and equipment everywhere. Thousands of local people moved from barasti (palm frond) houses into modern homes. Modern roads were built over the desert sand and fresh water supply and electricity were connected to every house. Education shifted from the religious system of 'Mutawiah' to a modern educational system and literacy classes were held for those who had not previously benefitted from education. The desert Bedouins began to receive medical services from clinics for the first time. His development venture succeeded in eradicating ages of backwardness. Sheikh Zayed also paid much attention to the environment and spend a lot of money to plant trees in the City of Al-Ain and the emirate of Abu Dhabi as a whole. He said "The process

of construction and development requires the efforts not only of the government but also of all the citizens of the UAE."

#### The Union

On the 2nd of December 1971 a union of six emirates was formed (Abu Dhabi, Ajman, Dubai, Al-Fujairah, Al-Sharjah, and Umm al-Quwain)



and the new state was known by the United Arab Emirates. Sheikh Zayed was elected a president to the union, and Sheikh Rashid Al Maktoum was elected the vice-president. Shortly, Ras Al-Khaimah joined the union, which was declared officially on 11 February 1972. When the British announced their intention to withdraw from the Gulf region after 150 years of complete control, Sheikh Zayed ceased the opportunity to draw a





political plan for the region. He convinced Sheikh Rashid bin Saeed al-Maktoum, the ruler of Dubai at the time, to join him In building a federation of nine emirates which were Abu Dhabi, Dubai, Ajman, Al-Fujairah, Ras Al-Khaimah, Al-Sharjah, and Umm al-Quwain, in addition to Bahrain and Qatar. Bahrain and Qatar preferred to work towards their complete independence, which drove Sheikh Zayed to exert more efforts to uphold the union with the remaining emirates.

## **Comprehensive Development**

The late Shaikh Zayed established an important principle is that the continuity of each emirate primarily is relying on the continuation of the Federation of UAE and any imbalance in the structure of the state will reflect negatively on the construction of each emirate.

Shaikh Zayed had stepped up efforts on the construction of vital infrastructure after the establishment of the UAE federation. This included agriculture which now has more than 600 thousand acres and the total green area amounts to more than one million acres.

The late Shaikh Zayed gave great impor-

tance to water and power projects due to its contribution to the growth of industrial and agricultural progress in the country. Water and electricity networks spread throughout the country to secure the needs of citizens of fresh water and meet the needs of agriculture, amounting to about 300 million gallons per day, according to statistics from the Ministry of Environment and Water.

The electricity linkage project between the emirates contributed to meeting the needs of the country, which has one of the largest and most sophisticated electricity networks in the region. During Shaikh Zayed's rule, the UAE witnessed substantial industrial development and investment. The amount spent on projects in 1995 amounted to nearly Dh13.7 billion.

Statistics said the total number of industrial installations in the UAE in 2003 was about 2,795 companies and factories.

#### **Education for All**

Sheikh Zayed paid so much attention to education. He inaugurated "The Nahyania School" in Al-Ain City in 1959 and so the number of schools and universities increased considerably across the country. One of Sheikh Zayed's first wide-scale initiatives for the UAE was the provision of education to all citizens. This resulted in schools and learning centers being built all over the country and the recruitment of teachers from other Arab countries to provide education to the younger generations.

Within a few years, the UAE was able to meet all the necessary education requirements for a



modern sovereign state. Sheikh Zayed's efforts in this culminated in the creation of a variety of accredited institutions such as the UAE University, the Higher Colleges of Technology and the Zayed University. The country also embraced a large number of private universities and colleges including Abu Dhabi University and Ajman University of Science and Technology. Besides, the UAE was one of the first countries to bring computer skills within its Curricula.



On the medical side, during the time of Sheikh Zayed, the number of medical institutions operating in the country increased considerably including public and private hospitals and medical centers and pharmacies which provide medical care for Emiratis and residents of the UAE.

#### **National Political Stance**

Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan established an excellent, wise and balanced foreign policy featured with standing by righteousness and justice as well as using dialogue and understanding in solving all the arising issues. His foreign policy is also based on achieving peace starting from his belief that peace is a need and a necessity for all humans.

Sheikh Zayed was the first to use oil as a weapon to stop the flow of American weapons to Israel in an attempt to change the course of the battle. His decision made an impact in the international stance to stand by the Arabs. He even delegated the Emirati Minister of Oil to the Arab Ministers of Oil Conference to discuss the use of oil in the war. And while the Arab ministers issued a resolution to decrease oil production 5 percent every month, Sheikh Zayed said: Arab oil is not dearer than Arab blood and gave his decision to his minister to announce the boycott of oil immediately from the countries which stand by Israel. That placed a pressure on the global decision concerning the war, which he viewed as a liberation war. He was the first Arab leader to stand by Egypt in its battle against Israel. He even offered his support to Egypt during October War.

#### **UAE Islands**

Sheikh Zayed refused to consider the issue of the three occupied Emirati Islands by Iran as a pretence to Iraq to continue its war with Iran. The UAE had a stance, which Sheikh Zayed Expressed through his project to stop the Iraqi-Iranian war.

And after the Iraqi invasion to Kuwait, 66,000 Kuwaiti citizens fled to the UAE and the Emirati people received them with generosity. Sheikh Zayed gave his order to provide them with accommodation and financial aids in addition to exempting them from paying any medical expenses.

Sheikh Zayed and Sheikh Jaber al-Ahmad al-Sabah shared a common approach of establish-



ing the Gulf Cooperation Council. Their vision become reality on 25 May 1981 in Abu Dhabi and Sheikh Zayed was elected the first president of the council and the first president to sign the GCC Charter.

## **Charity Work**

Charity works of the late Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan and his humanitarian contributions across the globe were countless and gained so much attention from all the countries of the world. Following are some of his humanitarian deeds and giving from the time he assumed the role of Ruler of Abu Dhabi in 1966 up until 2000:

### Arab Blood

- \* Sheikh Zayed supported Egypt and Syria in their 1973 war for the liberation of the Arab occupied territories in Palestine saying: Arab oil is not dearer than Arab blood.
- \* On 01 May 1974, Sheikh Zayed announce an increase in the capital of the Abu Dhabi Fund for Development, and on 06 November 1974, the UAE granted a new financial contribution to the Islamic Bank of 10 million Islamic Dinar to increase the total contributions of the UAE to the bank to 110 million Islamic Dinar.
- \* On 28 January 1976, the Abu Dhabi Fund for Development granted a loan of AED 40 million to the Ministry of Islamic Affairs in Morocco.
- \* On 11 February 1976, the fund granted two loans to Bahrain with a total amount of AED 160 million to finance electrical and industrial projects.
- \* On 16 February 1976, pursuant to the directions of Sheikh Zayed, the UAE Cabinet decided to provide urgent aid of \$100,000 to those who were affected by the earthquake, which hit Guatemala.
- \* On 29 February 1976, the UAE granted a zero-interest loan of \$2,400,000 to the UNISCO, and on 26 June 1976, the Abu Dhabi Fund for Arab Economic Development granted a loan of

AED40 million to finance development projects in Bangladesh.

#### Sanaa'- Ma'rib Road

On 29 September 1976, Sheikh Zayed attended the inauguration ceremony of Sanaa'- Ma'rib Road which cost around YER 187 million and paid by the UAE government.

On 22 December 1976, the Abu Dhabi Fund for Arab Economic Development granted a loan of AED 516 million to rural development projects in Darfur, West Sudan; on 17 February 1982, the fund granted a loan of \$500,000 to build the HQ of the Islamic Chamber of Commerce and Industry in Karachi; on 28 March 1982, the fund granted a loan of AED 259 million to the Senegal River Basin Countries; and on 10 April 1982, the UAE government, following the directions of Sheikh Zayed, sent an urgent aid of \$3 million to relief the impact of floods in Yemen.

On 11 February 1990 during the historical celebration held in Aswan, Egypt, Sheikh Zayed donated an amount of \$20 million to revive the old Alexandria library.

On 16 May 1990, Sheikh Zayed donated half million dollars to support the UAE-China Friendship Association; and on 26 February 1992, the Abu Dhabi Fund for Arab Economic Development signed three agreements with Syria in Damascus to finance three industrial projects with a total value of AED 911 million.

On 19 September 1992, the UAE government donated \$5 million to the Disaster Relief Fund in the US to help those who were affected by the floods of Hurricane Andrew which hit the State of Florida.

On 26 April 1993, the UAE government donated \$10 million to help the people of Bosnia and Herzegovina to overcome their ordeal.

On 25 June 1994, an agreement was signed to build an Islamic printing house in the Chinese capital Beijing with a donation of AED 3.1 million from Sheikh Zayed to support the activities of Muslim Chinese and spread the teachings of Islam.





















## MOI launches 2nd Unified Traffic Awareness Campaign

The Ministry of Interior launched the second unified traffic awareness campaign for 2018 under the slogan 'Sudden Deviation' within the initiatives of the traffic sector to improve road safety and achieve the highest levels of traffic safety, which is reaching 3 deaths per 100,000 people by 2021. The campaign will take place over three months period.

The campaign embodies the Ministry of Interior's strategy emanating from that of the Federal Government. It is also in line with the police leadership's directives to achieve the highest levels of traffic safety for all. It also falls within the traffic sector's strategic plan at the Ministry of Interior, which is to promote road safety and curtail traffic and run-over incidents and what they lead to deaths, injuries and losses.

Maj Gen Mohammed Saif Al Zafeen, Chairman of the Federal Traffic Council, said that reducing traffic accidents is a priority for both police and competent authorities in the country and for members of the public, due to the resulting deaths and injuries, and the negative social im-

pacts and material losses.

He noted that the new statistics released by the Traffic Coordination Directorate General at the Ministry of Interior points to sustaining 761 accidents as a result to Sudden Deviation with a percentage of 18% of the total number of traffic accidents in 2017. He also added that there were 95 deaths and 1,190 injuries and that deaths and injuries made 17.5% and 20.3% respectively in 2017.

Maj Gen Al Zafeen noted that the Ministry of Interior carries out this campaign in cooperation and coordination with the Traffic and Patrols Departments across the UAE, and other public and private entities concerned with traffic safety, which support these initiatives in order to create a safe environment and accidents-free roads.

He added that choosing the slogan 'Sudden Deviation' comes to follow the directions of Lt. General His Highness Sheikh Saif bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Interior. He pointed out that Sudden Deviation comes within the prime causes of traffic acci-







dents across the country and that it forms a real and serious hazard many drivers and road users do not realize, especially if it was accompanied by excessive speed which prevent the driver from controlling the vehicle and lead to serious traffic accidents.

He also stressed on the need to the support of the media to spread awareness within the community by using posters, brochures and leaflets. Media seminars will also be held and will host participating officials to communicate with the public about the campaign and disseminate traffic values and culture.

Maj Gen Al Zafeen called upon drivers and road users to adhere to road and traffic rules and codes to prevent traffic accidents which cost losses, injuries, and deaths, noting that adhering to road codes contributes to keeping the public safe from accidents.

He said that Federal Traffic Law imposed fines on violators in order to protect the public. He pointed to some articles of the executive regulations saying that the fine of Article 29 (Sudden Deviation) is AED1,000 and four traffic points; whereas the fine of Article 31 (Overtaking from a prohibited place) is AED600 and 6 traffic points. The fine of Article 83 (not using the indicator while changing lanes or sudden turns) is AED400; and Article 86 (Driving against traffic) impose a fine of AED400.

He noted that such objectives can be achieved by holding periodical meetings, exchanging experiences, spreading knowledge, coordinating between all the related parties to get creative ideas and innovative initiatives that reflect the interest of all the related parties in pushing the wheel of innovation and creativity forward and in execution to the



ambitions of our wise leadership in making the UAE one of the safest and most secure countries in the entire world.

The meeting aimed at increasing cooperation and strengthening partnership between the two sides as well as founding a unified mechanism between the RAK Police HQ and Saaed Association to serve the best interest of the public in regard to traffic control through awareness campaigns, communicating with the public, disseminating news, and holding diverse activities throughout the year. This would contribute to creating a conscious community and one that is accountable to saving lives in addition to enriching traffic culture amongst all road users across the emirate of Ras Al-Khaimah.



## New rules for driving and traffic started the UAE

New rules for driving and traffic started the UAE to apply the provisions of the amended Federal traffic law since 1 July 2017 Ministerial Decrees No 177 regarding the issuance and renewal of driving licenses, ministerial decision No 178 on procedures for emergency traffic on the list. Executive branch of the Federal Law No 21/1995 on the BIOS password, as amended by federal law No 12 of 2007, Ministerial Decree number (127) for the year 2008.

The UAE's amended federal traffic law came into effect on 1 July 2017. The new regulations aim to further protect the lives of road users and reduce traffic casualties from about 6 per 100,000 people to 3 per 100,000 as per Vision 2021.

# Ministerial Resolution No. 177 of 2017 regarding issuing and renewing a driver's licence

The resolution sets stipulations for issuing and renewing drivers' licences as the following:

For those who are 21 years of age and above

- \* Initially, the driver's licenses are valid for 2 years for citizens, GCC nationals and other nationalities
- \* After renewal, the driver's licence is valid for 10 years for citizens and GCC nationals and for 5 years for other nationalities.

For those below 21 years of age

\* Initially, the driver's licence is valid for one year for citizens, GCC nationals and other nationalities.

## Ministerial Resolution No. 178 of 2017 regarding traffic control rules

The resolution covers many safety and control aspects. Some of them are:

## Mandatory seat belts for all

- \* All passengers in a car are required to wear seat belts including those sitting in the rear seat, failing which the driver of the vehicle will be fined AED 400 and slapped with four black points.
- \* Children up to four years of age must be provided with a child safety seat. Violators will be fined AED 400 and slapped with four black points.
- \* The front seat passenger should also be at least 145 cm tall and not younger than 10 years old.

## **Reckless driving**

- \* Reckless driving will incur a fine of AED 2,000, 23 black points and impounding of the vehicle for a period of 60 days.
- \* The same punishment and fine will apply to drivers who endanger the lives of others.
- \* Other violations cover: blocking traffic, jumping red signals, sudden swerv-

ing and driving without a number plate.

## **Driving under the influence**

Drivers caught under the influence of drugs and or alcohol will have their licence suspended for one year, starting from the day of the verdict. Court will decide the fine and/or jail term.

### **Traffic signals**

Motorcycle riders and motorists who ignore traffic lights will be fined AED 1, 000 and incur a penalty of 12 points and their vehicles will be seized for a month.

#### **Distractions**

Using phones while driving or any other distractions will be attract AED 400 fine and four black points.

## Driver's behaviour

#### **Violations include:**

- \* throwing garbage
- \* not leaving safe distance between vehicles
- \* overtaking on the hard shoulder
- \* crowding around accident sites
- \* using quad-bike on road
- \* jaywalking





- \* violating technical and safety issues
- \* failing to fasten seat belts
- \* using expired tires
- \* driving without insurance/

car registration

- \* driving noisy vehicle
- \* transporting passengers illegally.

## **Speeding**

Those exceeding the speed limit by 80 kmph will be fined AED 3,000, slapped with 23 black points and have their car impounded for 60 days.

# Abu Dhabi Police calls on drivers to pay attention to cyclists

Abu Dhabi Police warned drivers from entering and using bicycle lanes and endangering the lives of cyclists.

Brigadier Ahmed Al Shehhi, Deputy Director of Traffic and Patrols Department in the Central Operations Section – Abu Dhabi Police, advised drivers to pay attention to cyclists, to reduce their speed when cyclists use the road, not to drive in bicycle lanes, not to get very close to cyclists since that might baffle them and could lead to accidents, injuries and even deaths.

Brigadier Al-Shehhi praised the government of Abu Dhabi for assigning special lanes to cyclists along the new Hodariyat Bridge in Abu Dhabi to add to the many bicycle lanes in the different parts of the city, including: Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan St., Arabian Gulf St., and King Abdullah bin Abdul Aziz St. in addition to bicycle lanes in the streets of Khalifa City, Mohammed bin Zayed City and

Shakhbout City as well as Al-Raha Beach and Al-Falah City.

He urged cyclists to practice their hobbies in the places that were assigned to them considering the spread of this sport amongst diverse classes of the community. He also pointed to the increase in the numbers of cyclists in the streets of the city who use bicycles for the purposes of sports and transportation and which goes in line with the healthy lifestyle.

He also emphasized on the need for sportsmen and cyclists to use bicycles in their assigned lanes and in parks, and to remain away from the traffic low and from crowded roads and streets as well as to avoid riding against the road direction and entering into restricted areas.



He also called on cyclists to abide by safety rules including the use of helmets, elbow and knee pads, in addition to equipping their bicycles with white headlight and red rear light while switching them on during night hours. He also asked cyclists to control their bikes using both hands and driving on the right side of the road in the direction of the traffic flow. He warned cyclists from hooking onto cars and other vehicles in the street or carry weights that might affect their balances.

He referred to article (1) of traffic law, which specified a fine of AED 2,000, impounding of the vehicle for a period of 60 days and 23 points for reckless driving. The same punishment and fine will apply to drivers who endanger the lives of others.





Car battery life spans between four to five years; however, not looking after it may lead to damages that could potentially discharge its energy and expires it before its due date. In this article, we will delve into the damages that might cripple batteries and how to deal with them to increase the longevity of its lifespan.

There are two types of batteries in cars: flooded batteries, which use liquids, and modern dry cell batteries.

In flooded batteries type, a user may check the condition of the battery by checking the level of liquids in it, and if the liquids are lesser that the required level, it should be refilled with distilled water. One of the common mistakes that lead to deteriorating the quality of the battery is the decrease of battery liquids.

On the other hand, users can check the health of dry cell batteries by looking into a crystal lens, if the color is green that means the battery is sufficiently charged. However, if the color is black it means it is flat or failing and needs changing.

A car battery may deteriorate for not using it for long times. People with more than one car or those who travel for long periods and leave their cars parked suffer from this problem. In such cases, the users should remove the battery and keep it in a specialized place (battery distributers, merchants) to store it in a safe manner and recharge it every 15 days. If you do not prefer to remove the battery, you may hand the car keys over to a relative or a friend in order to take it in a short ride once every week.

Professionals advise to clean the body of the battery and its terminals from dirt and other factors by using a rag made from materials resistant to static electricity in addition to cleaning the terminals from corrosion by using ammonia and Sodium Carbonate, of course after disconnecting the cables (negative one first).

Sometimes, the problem lies with the dynamo. If the charging capacity of the dynamo is lesser than the battery capacity, then the dynamo will not be able to compensate for the discharge. On the other hand, excessive charging could lead to a decrease in the liquids. Besides, high temperatures when the dynamo charging capacity is more than the battery capacity could lead to serious damages to the battery.

Other mistakes that could lead to a failing battery is using it while the car is parked for long periods of time, such as using it to watch movies inside the car with DVD player and a strong sound system. The battery uses chemical reaction to generate energy and using it this way would lead to damaging it in a short time.

Electric breakdowns may also have an effect on the battery, besides insisting on starting the engine when it refuses to could lead to a flat battery.

To maintain a healthy battery we advise you to check the dynamo at least once a year to gauge its charging capability. Also, check the liquids of the battery periodically as a part of the routine service (e.g. changing oil and checking coolant water).





The summer heat often compels us to pay extra attention to our health. However we often tend to forget that our cars, especially our tyres, need to be taken care of too. Considering the challenging summer climate in the region, high temperatures can become a serious problem for tyres, especially if they are not properly maintained.

Pierre Granzotto, General Manager for Passenger Cars and Vice President for Michelin Africa, India & the Middle East shares some key tips on how to maintain your tyres during the hot summer months:

## 1. Check all tyres regularly

All tyres - including the spare - should be checked regularly. One should look for any visible signs of wear or damage, such as deep cracks, exposed cables, cuts or uneven wear of the tyres.

The depth of the tyre tread indicates the remaining service life. To determine the tread depth, a tread depth gauge can be purchased and used. Whereas a new tyre usually has a depth of 8mm, the minimum legal requirement for a tread in motor cars is 1.6 mm, and motorists are recommended to change a tyre when its tread is 3 mm.

## 2. Check the tyre pressure

Tyre pressure is the life-blood of any tyre. Check the pressure of your tyres at least once a month. The air pressure in the tyre drops naturally at the rate of up to two pounds of air every month. However, high temperatures can increase the drop.

Apart from the fact that they wear more quickly, poorly inflated tyres generate more heat due to excessive sidewall flexing, affecting the overall performance of the vehicle, including braking distance, handling, safety and fuel consumption.

It is important to always check the pressure when the tyres are cold, meaning you have not driven the car for at least 2 hours or for not more than 3 km.

## 3. Check the tyre balance – if you feel vibration

Ensure that your tyres are properly balanced. If you feel vibration through the steering wheel or through the vehicle body, your tyres could be balanced incorrectly. Balancing helps prevent-premature wear of your tyres and eliminates vibration. It also protects the suspension, steering system and bearings of your vehicle.

## 4. Check the wheel alignment – your car seems to be drifting to one side

Ensure that your wheels are properly aligned. If your tyre has come into contact with a solid object, such as a kerb or pothole, or you have noticed uneven wear on your tyres, your suspension can be disrupted making your wheels sit at improper angles.

During summer, tyre discrepancies such as these must be monitored extra carefully. Uneven tyre alignment can affect the handling of the vehicle and will cause the tyres to wear unevenly and prematurely, which in turn may lead to a tyre burst.

There are several indicators of a misalignment; your car seems to be drifting to one side even when you think you're driving straight; your steering wheel vibrates; or you are driving straight but your steering wheel is not centred.

Tyre alignment should be checked and corrected by a professional.

## 5. Other tips to avoid tyre wear

Since tyres are the contact point between the vehicle and the road, drivers must pay extra attention to the safety of their vehicles. Periodical checks and repairs must be maintained throughout the year, and the summer is fast approaching, drivers must pay more attention to the aforementioned procedures.

Never overload your vehicle. Overloading increases tyre wear and fuel consumption, adversely affects vehicle handling and stability, and increases the braking distance. Moreover, keep an eye on the suspension. Old or worn shock absorbers can cause faster tyre wear and impact vehicle handling.
